SPRING CLEANING GUIDE

Before you start to clean, declutter first. It will be so much easier to clean a simplified home!

UNIVERSAL RULES

- Choose one area to focus on for a given cleaning session. Collect linens such as sheets, curtains
 or tablecloths and put them in the wash immediately. This way, they will be ready to be replaced
 once you have finished cleaning said area.
- Dust first! Dust builds up quickly and settles into every nook and cranny, so take your time removing as much of it as you can. Try to get every surface, working top to bottom, left to right. Here's a mini checklist of places to bust dust:
 - baseboards, ceiling fan blades, knick-knacks, the tops of TVs, picture frames, and wall hangings
- If possible, open some windows while you clean. Airing out stale spaces is a quintessential part of spring cleaning.
- Clean floors last! Sweep, vacuum, and mop all your floors.
